This training will address the principals of motivational interviewing and harm reduction. Nancy Cusack is a Licensed Psychologist with has been working with runaway, homeless youth and their families for the past twenty five years. She also works with adults who are struggling with Mental Illness. Nancy works at two area clinics: The Runaway Intervention program at MCRC, a child abuse advocacy center at Children's Hospital and North Suburban Counseling Center, a Community Mental Health Clinic. Nancy also consults with some area youth shelters and provides trainings in the areas of Ethics and Boundaries, Trauma, Mental Health, Adolescent Development and Post Modern Counseling Approaches.
